Grant evaluation

Grant types:

1. Short-term Scientific Missions (STSM)

Exchange visits for PhD students and researchers within ImmuParkNet. Opportunities for individuals to spend up to six months at an institution or laboratory based in a different country, which is part of the action.

Aim: share techniques and gain skills relevant for the action and that are not available in the home institution or laboratory.

Inclusiveness Target Countries Conference Grants (ITC)

ITC conference grants are grants aimed at young researchers and PhD students (under age of 40) from ITCs to attend beneficial international conferences that are not organized by COST Actions.

Inclusiveness Target Countries (ITC) are: Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, North Macedonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Montenegro, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, and Turkey.

Aim: presentation of own work by young researchers and innovators affiliated to ITC, for their participation at high-level conferences. Prioritized candidates will present at the

conferences that are evaluated as the most important ones regarding fulfilling the ImmuParkNet Action's goal.

2. Dissemination conference

Presentation of the work of ImmuParkNet (not own work) at high-level conferences by an Action participant.

Aim: Promote the ImmuParkNet to relevant research communities and potential stakeholders.

How to apply:

The applicant encodes a grant application by logging into e-COST and clicking on the Grant Applications tab.

After encoding the Grant application form, the applicant also needs to upload the actual application template completed which shall be previously downloaded from the application page. The applicant will need to upload additional supporting documentation for each type of grant.

All grant activities must be concluded by 15th October 2024 at the very latest to allow payment to occur.

Supporting documentation:

STSM

- STSM grant Application (based on e-COST template)
- Confirmation of the host on the agreement from the host institution in receiving the applicant
- Other documents required by the Action

ITC Conference

- ITC Conference grant application (based on e-COST template)
- Copy of the abstract of the accepted oral or poster presentation
- Acceptance letter from the conference organisers
- Other documents required by the Action

Dissemination Conference

- Dissemination conference grant application (based on e-COST template)
- Copy of the abstract of the accepted oral presentation
- Acceptance (or invitation) letter from the conference organisers.
